I. Payment Terms

SELLER reserves the right, at any time prior to final payment, to require BUYER to provide satisfactory additional security for performance of BUYER'S obligations. As you are aware this Firm represents the Sebring Airport Authority ("SAA"). This letter is to follow up on my correspondence of July 30, 2019. After noting the many issues with the claims made by Frasier Contracting, Inc.'s ("FCI") with regard to Building #103 I asked for additional documentation on the preparation of the slab. FCI has provided no response to my request.

At this time, in order to try and move this matter forward to resolution, SAA is willing to pay to FCI the sum of \$119,964.35 at this time. There is another \$46,949.15 that should sufficient backup be provided that will also be paid by SAA. The balance of FCI's claim is rejected. Below is the breakdown of the various categories from your original demand letter and also the outstanding Change Orders.

Please be advised this Firm represents the Sebring Airport Authority ("SAA") with regard to this matter. I have copied Thomas Saunders, Esq. who I understand to be FCI's counsel. I understand that Mr. Saunders gave permission for Bob Swaine, Esq., to speak with FCI directly on these matters, however, I am copying him in case that has changed.

I am in receipt of Frasier Contracting, Inc.'s ("FCI") letter dated June 18, 2019 (the "Letter"). This letter will serve as SAA's response.

In your Letter you provide 5 bullet points to "facilitate a seamless transition to Marmer Construction" for the work on Building 103. We do not believe there is any basis for FCI to set up hurdles to a seamless transition, particularly a demand for indemnification or payment of invoices of any type as referenced in the Letter.

First, let me respond to FCI's demand for indemnity. As you are aware Building 103 was the subject of a partial termination of FCI's contract with SAA. As noted in that termination letter the contract requires all design work done by Frasier, or others on its behalf, for Building 103 to be irrevocably licensed to SAA. There is no basis to demand an indemnity from SAA for the drawings, specifications, or any portion of the design. All design components are irrevocably assigned to SAA and SAA rejects any attempt to create indemnification obligations where such requirements do not exist under contract.

Second, let me address the various components of the invoice attached to the Letter. The demand contained in the invoice is wholly unacceptable. Given the overbreadth of the invoice it is not possible for SAA at this time to properly even evaluate FCI's claims. The invoice is improper for many reasons including:

- 1. Including line items for items already contained in general conditions.
- 2. The storage costs for steel were incurred by FCI due to its own fervor to purchase materials. FCI moved forward with such purchases despite being explicitly told by SAA not to purchase these materials. Once that decision was made by FCI all further costs related to that decision are to be borne by FCI. There is no basis to transfer such costs to SAA.
- 3. The powerlift door deposit is unclear which building that went to or if it has been transferred to Marmer if part of Building 103.
- 4. Inclusion of overhead and profit when the same are specifically excluded from recovery under the contract in the case of a termination.
- 5. Interest for unknown items and if related to the steel purchase to be borne by FCI.
- 6. Inclusion of legal fees and a note that there "may be additional charges and legal fees." There's no justification for such a claim.

As noted above SAA cannot evaluate FCI's claim for additional costs when so many items are included for which FCI is not entitled under the contract or law. SAA will not simply engage in a discussion with FCI to "split the baby" or try and reach a compromise working from such overinflated and unjustifiable demands by FCI. Should FCI wish to provide those claims for which there exist a truly contractual basis then SAA may consider those as appropriate.

The failure to specifically delineate a basis to reject the invoice does not mean such is waived by SAA. SAA specifically reserves all defenses to the claims made by FCI.

In many locations within the airfield and Commerce Park, the existing stormwater pipes have failed and

runoff is eroding away soil and bypassing treatment control structures. In the past, failures have been limited to airfield grass areas. Stormwater pipes cross underneath taxiway and apron pavement in many places where a pipe failure would result in structural collapse of pavement. This is also true of the Commerce Park where old infrastructure cross roadways, parking lots and driveways. Due to effects of and damage sustained during Hurricane Irma, this condition has worsened considerably.

Stormwater Drainage Improvements

A project to evaluate the overall drainage system and provide a rehabilitation design which will remedy the problems and restore water quality treatment capacity to the stormwater system is needed. The

rehabilitation design and construction will be phased and prioritized. Figure 1 depicts the existing stormwater system and the various construction/rehab packages. A project of this type would allow the Sebring Regional Airport and Commerce Park to continue functioning as a platform for job creation and economic development. Improved infrastructure on site will enhance economic resiliency through attracting new businesses and therefore job growth, as well as maintaining the ability to perform normal business operations quickly after a future disaster. The site is listed in the Region's Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) as a Key Opportunity and Investment Area.

Working with County staff, County's grant consultant, and SAA consultant Atkins, SAA staff is recommending applying for an EDA Grant to help fund stormwater infrastructure replacement. Part of the application package is a Resolution regarding the 20% grant match. The EDA wants conformation that if grant is awarded, applicant can provide funds for match. This assurance to EDA is provided in the Resolution.

If grant is awarded, SAA responsibilities will be to keep up with the project schedule and various reporting requirements (through a straightforward online portal) and of course provide the match for the grant.


Job creation/retention, businesses can stipulate 3, 6, or 9 years for their job commitments/projections in terms of both job creation and job retention. The only verification activity is between the EDA and the applicant. The businesses will need to provide information to SAA, but they will not have to provide any verification or reporting directly to the EDA.

There is no ramification for the business. The only reach-back mechanism the EDA has to the SAA are annual reporting requirements on the rolled job commitment totals included in the application. If numbers are below target, the EDA would typically ask for a plan from the applicant on how they are working to get closer to the projected numbers.

RESOLUTION SAA 21-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE SEBRING AIRPORT AUTHORITY ESTABLISHING AN AUTHORIZED ORGANIZATIONAL REPRESENTATIVE AND DIRECTING THEM TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL GRANT FUNDING AND COMMITTING MATCHING FUNDS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Sebring Airport Authority ("SAA"), a body politic created by Florida law, was established by the Florida Legislature and operates pursuant to Chapter 189, Florida Statutes and operates pursuant to the Laws of Florida, Chapter 2005-300; and

WHEREAS, the SAA owns and leases real property and operates an airport located at the Sebring Regional Airport and Industrial Park in Highlands County, Florida (herein referred to as the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the SAA was established to acquire, lease as lessee or lessor, construct, reconstruct, improve, extend, enlarge, equip, repair, maintain, and operate the airport and other industrial facilities which are located on the Property; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Laws of Florida, Chapter 2005-300, the SAA is authorized to enter into cooperative agreements or otherwise contract or participate with the Federal Government; and

WHEREAS, the SAA seeks to leverage EDA funding to further develop the Multimodal Logistics Center (MLC) located on the Property of the Sebring Regional Airport. The airport is a hub of entrepreneurship, small business development, and employment retention/growth, continuing the positive trend of providing opportunities for community-based and sustainable economic growth; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Economic Development Administration's Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Program (CFDA 11.307) provides federal grant funding which can be used to assist in development of this project; and,

WHEREAS, the SAA has the financial capability to provide the required minimum nonfederal match.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SEBRING AIRPORT AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Authorized Organizational Representative (AOR) Designation.

The SAA hereby designates the SAA Executive Director as the Authorized Organizational Representative (AOR) to apply for grants administered by the Economic Development Administration (EDA), including the Economic Adjustment Assistance program.

As the AOR, the SAA Executive Director is approved to execute agreements and to obligate funds pursuant to section C(2) "Matching Share" as required by the Federal Funding Opportunity for Economic Adjustment Assistance Program.

SECTION 2. Authorization to Apply.

The SAA hereby authorizes the SAA Executive Director as the Authorized Organizational Representative (AOR), to apply for funding through the Economic Development Administration (EDA) Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance grant program.

SECTION 3. Commitment of Matching Funds.

The SAA approves that it has the financial capability and, if awarded the grant, commits to provide the necessary amount to satisfy the non-federal match requirements.

The SAA acknowledges that at the time of the award of the grant, non-federal contributions, 80% of the total project cost estimate of \$2,287,759, in the amount of \$457,551 will: (i) be committed to the project for the period of performance, (ii) be available as needed, and (iii) not be conditioned or encumbered in any way that may preclude its use consistent with the requirements of EDA investment assistance.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

WHEREAS, the Authority was approved for a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) dated September 5, 2018 grant #3-12-0072-025-2018 for improvements to the runway apron in the amount of \$7,000,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the Authority was approved for a grant from FDOT dated November 26, 2018 grant #441686-1-94-01 for improvements to the runway apron in the amount of \$523,802.00 and amended agreement dated October 9, 2019 grant #441686-1-94-01 in the amount of \$253,976.00, and

WHEREAS, the Authority was approved for an increase in grant # 444395-1-94-01 from FDOT dated October 26, 2021 for improvements to the existing railroad spur in the amount of 2,181,559.00, and

WHEREAS, the Lender is providing a revolving line of credit in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 for funding the costs of these improvements until grant funds can be reimbursed; and

WHEREAS, the loan is secured by a pledge of the grant funds and is being updated to reflect additional grants that have been pledged.

THIS AMENDED LOAN AGREEMENT (the "LOAN AGREEMENT") is made and entered into this <u>16thay of December</u>, 2021 by and between HEARTLAND NATIONAL BANK, a national banking association (hereinafter "LENDER") and Sebring Airport Authority ("BORROWER") to amend the Loan Agreement dated July 18, 2019 and Amended September 19, 2019.

WHEREAS, BORROWER was approved for a grant from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) dated November 26, 2018 grant #444395-1-94-01 for improvements to the existing rail spur in the amount of \$\$759,917.00 and amended agreement dated October 9, 2019 grant #444395-1-94-01 in the amount of \$2,937,442.00

WHEREAS, BORROWER was approved for a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) dated September 5, 2018 grant #3-12-0072-025-2018 for improvements to the runway apron in the amount of \$7,000,000.00, and

WHEREAS, BORROWER was approved for a grant from the Florida Department of Transportation dated November 26, 2018 grant #441686-1-94-01 for improvements to the runway apron in the amount of \$523,802.00 and amended agreement dated October 9, 2019 grant #441686-1-94-01 in the amount of \$253,976.00, and

WHEREAS, BORROWER was approved for an increase in grant # 444395-1-94-01 from the Florida Department of Transportation dated October 26, 2021 for improvements to the existing railroad spur in the amount of 2,181,559.00, and

WHEREAS, LENDER is providing a revolving line of credit in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 for funding the costs of these improvements until grant funds can be reimbursed (hereinafter "LOAN"), and

WHEREAS, BORROWER's Board of Directors has approved a resolution authorizing the LOAN and the repayment to be paid to the LOAN from such grant proceeds,

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the promises and covenants contained herein and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the parties, and of the mutual covenants and agreements contained in this Loan Agreement, the BORROWER and the LENDER agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1. RECITALS: DEFINITIONS

Section 1.1 Recitals. The recitals contained hereinabove are true and correct.

Section 1.2 **Defined Terms.** For purposes of this Loan Agreement, the following terms shall have the respective meanings as specified in this section (such meanings to be equally applicable to both the singular and plural forms of the terms defined):

Agreement, shall mean this Loan Agreement as originally executed by the parties hereto and all permitted amendments and modifications hereof, including all exhibits and schedules.

Loan Documents, shall mean this Loan Agreement, the Note, the Security Agreement, and all other documents, agreements, certificates, schedules, notes, statements of opinions, however described, referenced herein or executed and delivered pursuant hereto or in connection with or arising from the Loan or the transactions contemplated by this Loan Agreement.

Loan(s), shall mean the loan as evidenced by Promissory Note executed July 18, 2019.

ARTICLE 2. FUNDING

Section 2.1 Draws.

a.

BORROWER will provide copies of the following for draws:

- Application for Payment reflecting the percentage of completion of the projects executed by the contractor, project engineer, and BORROWER
- Documents submitted to the FDOT or FAA monthly for funds due under the grant, or invoices for materials purchased
- Submission of a work in progress report showing the amount of each grant, amount drawn to date under each grant, the amount remaining due under each grant and the amount of the current draw requested
- No more than one draw for either grant will be outstanding and unpaid at any time
- b. Disbursements shall be paid monthly.

ARTICLE 3. REPAYMENT

Section 3.1 Repayment.

a. Upon receipt of the funds paid by FDOT and FAA under the grants, BORROWER will immediately pay same amount to LENDER. If grant funds are cancelled, payment will be made by BORROWER from other BORROWER legally available funds

ARTICLE 4. COLLATERAL

Section 4.1 Collateral.

- a. The LOAN will be secured by a lien upon and pledge of the following Grants:
 - Florida Department of Transportation Grant Agreement #441686-1-94-01 dated November 26, 2018 in the amount of \$523,802.00, amended October 9, 2019 in the amount of \$253,976.00, and amended October 26, 2021 in the amount of \$2,181,559.00,

- Florida Department of Transportation Grant Agreement #444395-1-94-01dated November 26, 2018 in the amount of \$759,917.00 and amended October 9, 2019 in the amount of \$2,937,442.00,
- The U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Aviation Administration Grant Agreement #3-12-0072-025-2018 in the amount of \$7,000,000.00

ARTICLE 5. FUNDING

Section 5.1 Once the total expended on the project totals the amount of the grants approved and pledged to the loan, additional funding will not be available until additional grants, satisfactory to the bank are received.

ARTICLE 6. MISCELLANEOUS

Section 6.1 <u>Amendments, etc.</u> No amendment, modification, termination or waiver of any provision of this Loan Agreement, the Note(s), or other Loan Documents, nor consent to any departure by the BORROWER therefrom, shall in any event be effective unless the same shall be in writing and signed by LENDER, and then such waiver or consent shall be effective only in specific instances and for the specific purpose for which given.

Section 6.2 <u>Time of the Essence.</u> Time is of the essence to this Loan Agreement, the Note(s), and the other Loan Documents.

Section 6.3 <u>Headings.</u> The headings in this Loan Agreement are intended to be for convenience of reference only, and shall not define or limit the scope, extent or intent or otherwise affect the meaning of any portion hereof.

Section 6.4 <u>Counterparts.</u> This Loan Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument and any one of the parties hereto may execute this Loan Agreement by signing such counterpart.

Section 6.5 <u>Further Assurances.</u> The BORROWER shall, from time to time, execute such additional documents as may be requested by LENDER or LENDER's counsel, to carry out the terms and fulfill the intent and purpose of this Loan Agreement and the Loan Documents.

Section 6.6 <u>**Coverning Law.</u>** This Loan Agreement has been delivered in the State of Florida and shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the laws of Florida. Wherever possible, each provision of this Loan Agreement shall be interpreted in such manner as to be effective and valid under applicable law, but if any provision of this Loan Agreement shall be</u>

ineffective, the invalidity of such provision will not affect the enforceability of the remainder of this Loan Agreement.

Section 6.7 <u>WAIVER OF TRIAL BY JURY.</u> BORROWER AND LENDER HEREBY KNOWINGLY, VOLUNTARILY AND INTENTIONALLY WAIVE THE RIGHT EITHER MAY HAVE TO TRIAL BY JURY IN ANY ACTION ARISING OUT OF, OR BASED UPON, THIS Loan Agreement, THE PROMISSORY NOTE(S) REPRESENTING THE LOAN(S), THE COLLATERAL FOR THE LOAN(S), AND ANY AGREEMENT CONTEMPLATED TO BE EXECUTED IN CONJUNCTION HEREWITH, OR ANY COURSE OF CONDUCT, COURSE OF DEALING, STATEMENTS (WHETHER WRITTEN OR VERBAL) OR ACTIONS OF EITHER PARTY. THIS PROVISION IS A MATERIAL INDUCEMENT FOR LENDER EXTENDING CREDIT TO BORROWER.



- 24" RCP storm pipe is onsite, but not yet installed at station 33+50.
